

Landscape Design Rebate Application: Rules & Requirements

1. An original dated sales receipt showing itemized cost for the rebated purchased/payment must be provided. **Receipts of purchased/payment prior to February 2025 shall not be accepted.** For online purchases, a digital version of the final invoice is required.
2. **The last day to submit a rebate application is May 1, 2026.** First-come, first-served until funds are depleted or deadline date reached.
3. Applicants that have completed and received the rebate for the MWD Turf Replacement Program (TRP) **ARE NOT** eligible for this program.
4. This rebate requires the applicants to submit their landscape design plans to MWD's Turf Replacement Program. The submitted landscape designs must be approved by MWD staff or its designated representative.
5. Documentation(s) and proof of approval from MWD's TRP program via a "Letter to Proceed" shall be provided to FMWD.
6. The rebated landscape design plans shall be prepared for the existing address located within the service area of a member water agency that Foothill MWD serves. Depending on the applicant's retail water agency, the rebate may be applied as a credit on a subsequent water bill or be issued in the form of a check.
7. **Rebate amount is \$1000** per parcel (or actual cost of design, whichever is less).
8. Foothill MWD does not endorse specific landscaping design plans; nor does it guarantee materials or workmanship; acceptance of such is customer's responsibility.
9. All rebate applications must be signed by the legal property owner.
10. Foothill MWD assumes no responsibility or liability for any damage that may occur to an applicant's property as a result of participation in the program. Due to circumstances beyond its control, Foothill MWD cannot guarantee that installation of rebated fixtures will result in lower utility costs.
11. By submitting an application, you agree to release and hold FMWD harmless for any damages or harm that may result from your participation in the program.
12. By applying, you acknowledge you understand that your application and FMWD's response to it may be subject to the Public Records Act.
13. **The IRS requires all rebate program participants receiving \$600 or more per calendar year in rebates to be issued an IRS Form 1099 unless exemptions apply. If you received rebates from Foothill MWD or designee totaling \$600 or more in the current calendar year, you must submit a completed IRS W-9 form with your rebate application to receive a rebate.** The Social Security or Tax ID number requested in the rebate application process is in compliance with exemptions to the Federal Privacy Act of 1974, 42 UCS 405(c)(2)(c). Social Security numbers provided as part of the application process are held in confidence under terms of the Privacy Act and are not divulged or otherwise conveyed to individuals or organizations outside the Foothill MWD Rebate Program.
14. Foothill MWD may at any time, modify, suspend, or terminate this program without prior written notice. Incomplete or illegible applications will be denied.
